Bulletin #7 – Phase 2 Short-Listed Corridors

Bulletin #5, issued in December 2020, provided an update on the outcome of the Stage 1 Assessments, noting which corridors have been discounted and which have been retained for further assessment.

The shortlisted corridors advanced to the Stage 2 Assessment are described below:

- In the **Northern Section** of the scheme, two variations of the Online **Red** Corridor will be assessed at Stage 2 – these are named **Corridor 1A (North)** and **Corridor 1B (North)**. These two corridors differ only in the area of Bray South.
- In the **Southern Section** of the scheme, the Online **Red** Corridor and the Offline **Cyan** Corridors will be assessed at Stage 2. In addition, a further corridor – named the Offline **Purple** Corridor – will also be assessed at Stage 2. It should be noted that the Purple Corridor comprises of an underground tunnel option, tying into the online corridor at Glenview to the north and tying in near Kilpedder to the south.

The shortlisted corridor advanced to the Stage 2 Assessment are now available to view through the interactive web mapping browser, which can be accessed by clicking on the link below.

It is possible to zoom in/out and pan around the mapping to ascertain the full extent of the corridors currently being assessed at Stage 2.

The corridors shown are in draft form and are still subject to change. As the Project progresses, more detailed assessments, on-going studies and the incorporation of information received from the public may result in changes to these corridors.

It is important to note that the corridors as they have been currently presented provide a basis upon which assessments can be undertaken, taking cognisance the level of detail available at this stage of the project. The corridor boundaries do not constitute a land acquisition or physical scheme boundary and these will not be developed until Phase 3 of the project (Design and Environmental Evaluation).
